



Advisory for candidates regarding COVID-19

This is to inform you that the Amar Jyoti Institute of Physiotherapy (University of Delhi) will be implementing safety measures as per Government of India (GOI) guidelines in current scenario of COVID-19 to ensure health & safety of the candidates. Adequate measures will be implemented for safety of all without compromising the high standards, sanctity, and fairness in the conduct of the examination. It is mandate that candidates strictly adhere to stipulated guidelines and the process for Social Distancing and hygiene to ensure their own safety & health and that of their fellow candidates.

Also for safety purposes, we strongly advise candidates not to bring anything other than permitted items. **THERE ARE NO PROVISIONS FOR THE STORAGE OF PERSONAL ITEMS.**

Preparation at centre

1. Standard Operating Procedures for implementing safety precautions and for maintaining required standard of hygiene will be implemented.
2. Before the examination, the seating Area and all contact surfaces will be thoroughly disinfected.
3. Gap between 2 seats will be maintained as per GOI guidelines.
4. Hand Sanitizers will be available at entry and inside the exam venue for candidates and centre staff to use.
5. The seating plan will be informed to the candidate at the screening station.
6. As much as possible it will be ensured that all the processes are touch free to ensure safety.
7. Candidate should reach the centre as per the Reporting/Entry time stated on the Admit Card to avoid crowding at the centre at the time of entry and to maintain social distancing.

Pre-Exam Preparation

1. Candidate should check Reporting/ Entry time, gate number at the centre given in the Admit Card.
2. Candidate should fill self-declaration cum consent form as per instructions completely and properly. The form should be endorsed (signed) by your parents/ Guardian prior to

entry. CANDIDATE WILL SIGN THE FORM AT THE CENTRE IN FRONT OF THE CENTRE STAFF WHEN INSTRUCTED.

3. Candidates will be permitted to carry only certain items with them into the venue:
 - a. Exam related documents Admit Card, ID card, etc. (Please refer to the Instructions to candidate for more details)
 - b. A simple transparent Ball Point Pen
 - c. Personal hand sanitizer (50 ml)
 - d. Personal transparent water bottle

At time of Entry

1. Candidates need to maintain a space of at least 6 feet from each other at all times. They should strictly follow the instructions provided by the centre staff.
2. Seating plan will not be displayed outside the centre to avoid any crowding at any one place.
3. Candidates will be required to wear gloves and sanitize hands before entry in centre. Hand sanitizer will be available at various locations in the centre.
4. Candidate should bring Admit card and duly filled self- declaration cum consent form as per instructions. Candidate will need to sign the form when instructed.
5. It is mandatory that the candidate wear a fresh 3 Ply mask before entry.
6. Candidate should bring Identity Proof and other documents as advised in the instructions to candidate.
7. Do not bring prohibited items to exam centre as there are no arrangements available for safe keeping your belongings.
8. At time of entry, Admit Card, duly filled self-declaration cum consent form and body temperature (using Thermo Guns) will be checked and centre staff will guide you to respective rooms after checking Admit Card. Candidates are required to strictly adhere to instructions provided by centre staff.
9. Please observe that no-one will be denied permission to appear for examination, until he/she violates the covid-19 directives/advisories of Government (Central/State) applicable on the day of exam and instructions mentioned on the Admit Card.

During Examination

1. Candidate will be required to fill all details on OMR sheet, sign on the self-declaration cum consent form in front of invigilator when asked to do so. (After sanitizing hands)
2. Candidates should wear mask at all times during examination and at the centre.
3. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall before 3 hrs.

After Examination:

1. On completion of examination, the candidates will be permitted to move out in an orderly manner one candidate at a time. Please wait for instructions from invigilator and do not get up from your seat until advised.
